

Ninja Coffee Maker Cleaning Checklist

Follow this checklist to clean your Ninja Coffee Maker with vinegar for optimal brewing performance:

1. **Pre-Cleaning Prep**:

- Unplug your Ninja Coffee Maker.
- Remove and empty the carafe, filter, and grounds.
- Rinse removable parts (carafe, filter basket, etc.) with warm water.

2. **Prepare Vinegar Solution**:

- Mix **equal parts of distilled white vinegar** and **water**.
- Pour the mixture into the water reservoir (up to the max fill line).

3. **Run Cleaning Cycle**:

- Press the **CLEAN** button (if available), or run a regular brew cycle.
- Pause for **30-60 minutes** to allow the vinegar solution to sit inside the machine.

4. **Flush & Rinse**:

- Discard the vinegar solution.
- Refill the reservoir with **fresh water**.
- Run **2-3 rinse cycles** with clean water until no vinegar smell remains.

5. **Clean Removable Parts**:

- Wash the carafe, filter basket, and other removable parts with soapy water.
- Dry thoroughly and reassemble.

6. ****Wipe Down Exterior****:

- Use a damp cloth to clean the warming plate, control panel, and exterior surfaces.

7. ****Troubleshooting Tips****:

- If vinegar smell persists, run extra water-only cycles.
- Ensure all parts are dry before reassembling.
